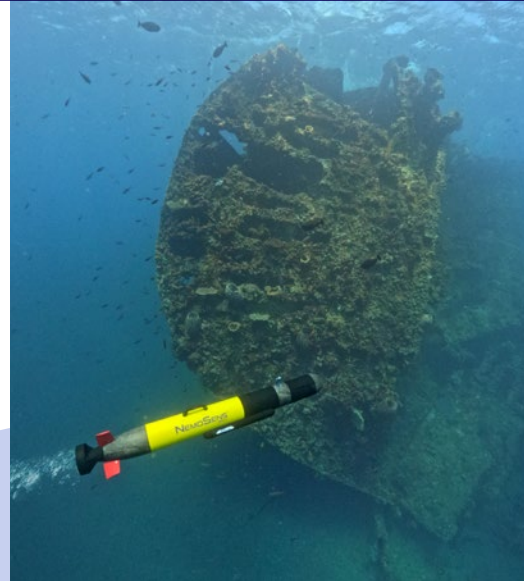

MARITIME EQUIPMENTS

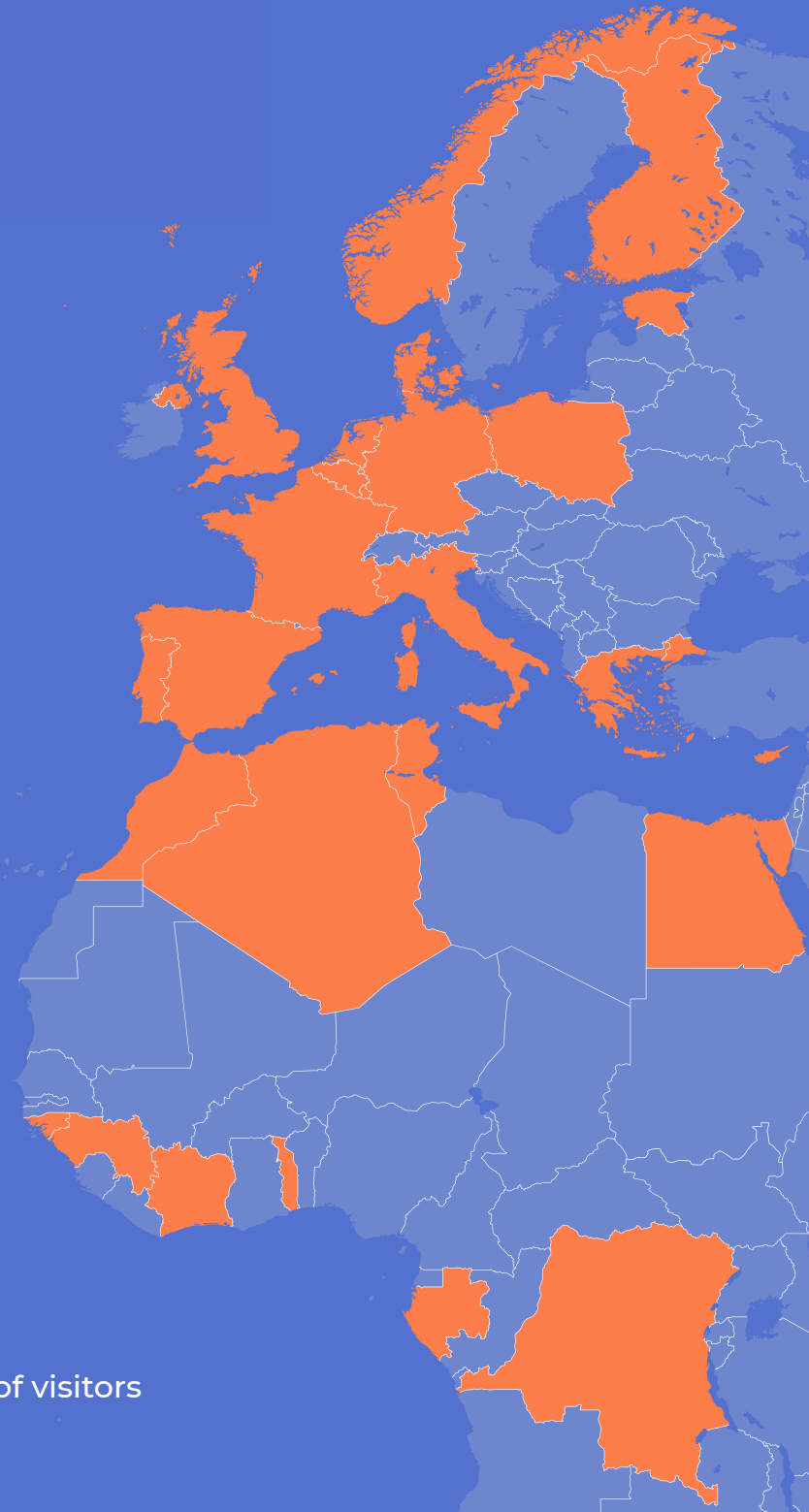
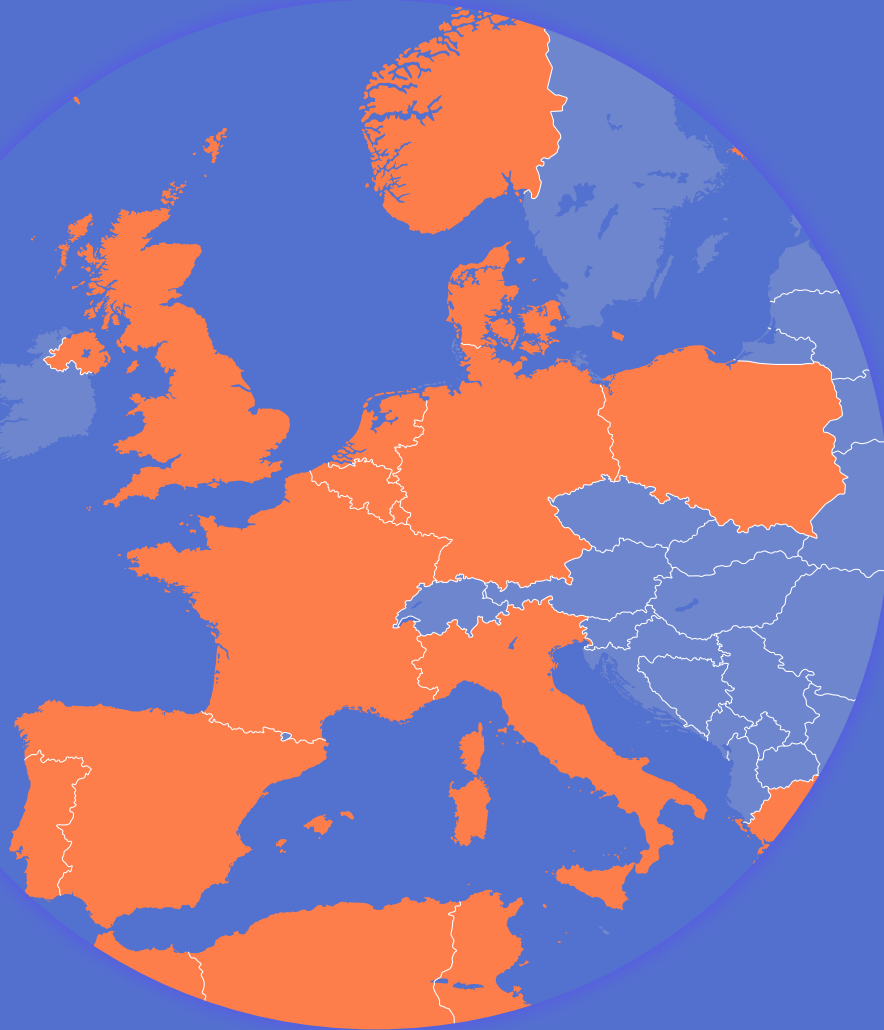

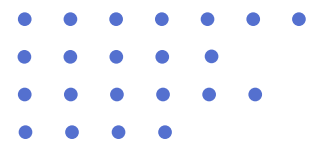
